**THIS MATTER** came before the Court on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of October 2003 upon the Petition of Wesley C. Smith ("Petitioner") for the expungement of protective order records pursuant to Va. Code Ann. §19.2-392.2;

**UPON CONSIDERATION** whereof, the evidence, exhibits, and the arguments and representations of Petitioner's counsel and the attorney for the Commonwealth;

**IT APPEARS TO THE COURT** that:

1. On September 19, 2002, a Preliminary Protective Order ("PPO") was issued and served on Petitioner, in the matter styled Cheri Smith, Petitioner v. Wesley Smith, Respondent, Case No. JA42997-01-00;

2. On October 1, 2002, Petitioner appeared before the Juvenile and Domestic Relations District Court of Prince William County for hearing on the PPO;

3. Upon hearing the evidence and arguments of the parties, the PPO was dismissed, and the matter was concluded;

4. Timely service of the Petition for expungement filed herein was served on the Commonwealth;


5. The Court has received a valid set of Petitioner's fingerprints;

7. The Commonwealth does not object to the Court's granting the Petition; it is


therefore

**ADJUDGED, ORDERED and DECREED** that the Clerk of this Court shall cause a copy of this Decree be forwarded to the Department of State Police, which shall, pursuant to rules and regulations adopted pursuant to Virginia Code § 9.1-134, direct the manner by which the appropriate expungement or removal of such records shall be effected. + The clerk shall send a copy to Prince William County office of the Commonwealth's attorney.
